10 Prayer Helps

PRAISE - Praise God for his love, holiness, greatness, faithfulness, word, salvation,...

WAITING on the LORD - A time of silence before God. "Be still and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10).

CONFESSION - Say sorry. Repent from sin. Remove spiritual blockages between you & God (Isaiah 59:1-2).

PRAYING SCRIPTURE - Turn parts of Scripture into prayers. Prayer shaped by Scripture.

WATCHING - Be aware of the spiritual battle (Colossians 4:2).

INTERCESSION - Praying for others

PETITIONS - Praying for your personal needs.

THANKSGIVING - Thank God for what he has done for you and for others, including answers to prayer.

SONG - Pray through the Psalms.

MEDITATION - Thinking deeper on WHO God is, WHAT he has done, WHO I am, or WHAT I do.
